### Patrons' Policy

- You have the right to be treated with dignity and respect by the staff, the Board of Directors, volunteers and your fellow patrons. Likewise, you are responsible for treating the staff, Board of Directors, volunteers and your fellow patrons with dignity and respect.
- You have the right and privilege to enjoy our facility, including each of the exhibits, many of which are provided by our generous donors. You have a responsibility to let any staff member know if there is a problem with the facility or any of the exhibits, including any mistreatment or abuse by fellow patrons. Please leave each exhibit in the same or better condition than you found it to help us maintain a clean and safe museum.
- You have the responsibility to make sure the child(ren) you bring to the museum is/are being supervised by a parent or trusted adult selected by the parent at all times while at the museum.
- You have the responsibility to conduct yourself in a safe manner towards members, guests, board members and staff while at the museum. If KACM determines that any member, guest, board member or staff poses a serious risk of harm to our staff, members, or guests of the museum we have the right to remove said person from the museum.

This Policy has been adopted to ensure the safety and smooth operation of the Museum. Any violation of this Policy may result in a staff member asking you and your party to leave the premises.
