### Why do you choose to volunteer at the museum?

The opportunity for me to volunteer at the Kearney Area Children's Museum came up for me several years ago through the Kearney Dobytown Kiwanis Club's sponsorship of the Train Zone. Paul Braden was assuming responsibility for the Train Zone and asked for volunteers to assist with keeping the train tracks cleaned. I volunteered because I remembered how much my now adult children enjoyed the Museum when they were growing up. I appreciated the fact of its existence then and felt that volunteering to help with the trains was a great way to pay it back for today's children. I have continued to volunteer because it is very rewarding to watch the enjoyment of the children watching the trains. Especially rewarding are the looks of wonder and awe of the 1–3-year-old children peering at the trains running at the same level of their faces. The looks on their faces is the greatest reward there is for me.

### What is your advice for someone considering volunteering at KACM?

The Museum has a wide variety of exhibits that will capture an area of interest for each volunteer. Thus, there should be something that appeals to any volunteer's interest. Each area needs some degree of being maintained. The Museum has a variety of activities for children during the day and special evening events that could be of potential interest for a volunteer. My advice is to visit the Museum and learn about its features and activities and then visit with a staff member and inquire about the volunteer needs of the Museum. There will generally be something that could appeal to a potential volunteer's interests and skills. Each member of the staff is easy to visit and work with.

### Why is the museum vital to our community?

The Museum is a city and area treasure. It has valuable experiential learning and entertainment activities focusing on stimulating the imaginations of children. Children get to have hands-on activities in a wide variety of areas including construction, a grocery store, food production, a science area with a variety of hands-on activities, a police car, fire truck, ambulance and a mail truck. Children can play being a doctor, operate the trains and do arts and crafts or enjoy read-aloud-time. It is the only place where a family can experience all of the exhibits or activities under one roof in the region.



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
